The purpose of this letter is to express my concern and request information on the health, whereabouts, and charges against Mr. Georghe-Emil Ursu, age 59, resident Romania, 8 Ho-Si-Min Street, Apt. 24, Sector 6, a civil engineer with the I.S.L.G.C. Design Institute on Snagov Street in Bucharest.

It is my understanding that he disappeared from his office on September 21, 1985 and that he is now held by Romanian security forces.

Please convey to your government my concern for Mr. Georghe-Emil Ursu.

I would also like to request that the appropriate Romanian authorities review his case and expedite his early release. I am looking forward to hearing from you on this matter.
